### Leadership Training in School

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action. They identified various objects that are red in colour.

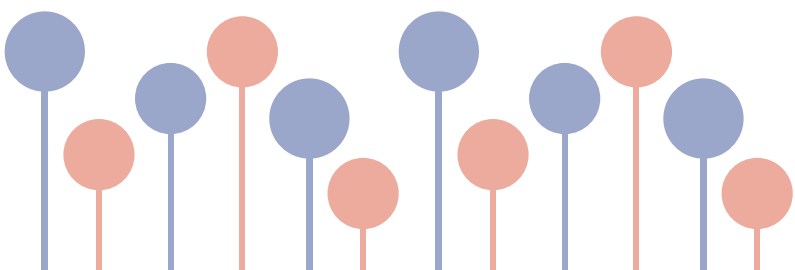
It helped students classify objects based on the colour red, thereby helping in developing cognitive skills.

## Star of the Week

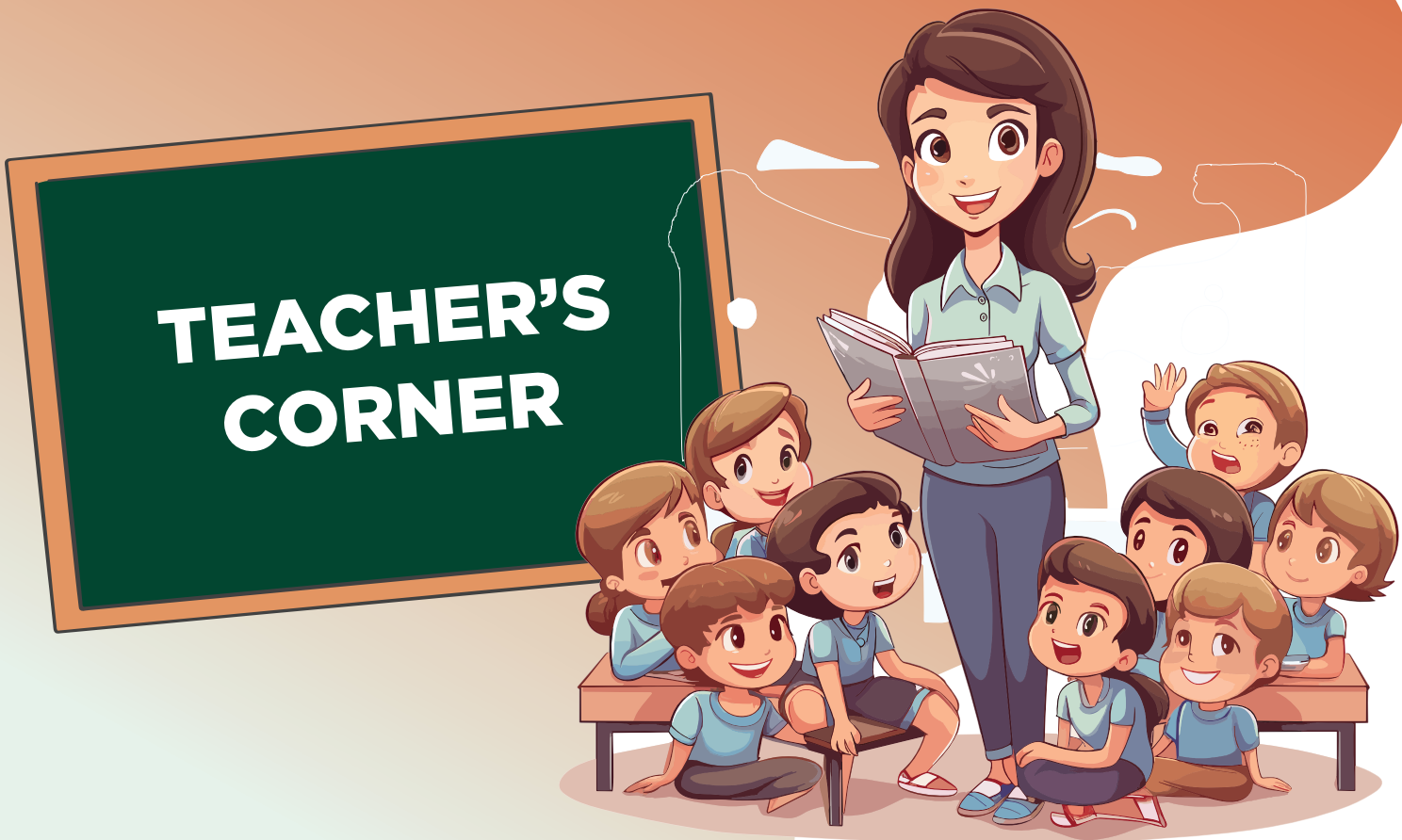
