One million plastic bottles are bought globally every minute, and up to five trillion plastic bags are used annually. The next most popular things are stirrers, plastic bottles, plastic bottle caps, plastic supermarket bags, and plastic food wrappers. Many of us use these things daily without giving them a second thought. As members of the student fraternity, we may each take little steps to lessen plastic waste. We at RIAH are dedicated to giving our students new experiences and encouraging learning environments in addition to academics.

# Highlights of the initiative
